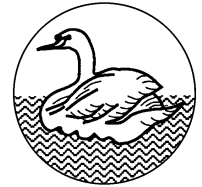

“Call Parents” system

It is now several months since the school installed the automated system for notification of parents when children are not registered as being in school. It has been helping us to improve the school's attendance records, but the main reason for the system is to ensure the safety of the children. It provides a quick alert to parents that their child is not in school. The parents should then contact the school to notify us if they know where the child is, and why he/she is absent.

Occasionally, if a child is late, the automated message may coincide with a child's arrival at school, or be sent before he/she has been able to be registered. This is easily cleared up when the call to the school is made. We are sorry for the slight anxiety that may be caused, but are sure it is a small price to pay for the early notice it affords if a child is missing.
